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MANUSCRIPT DETAILS

TITLE: A survey of China's community-based elderly care service models from the perspective of welfare pluralism

ABSTRACT: China's Ministry of Civil Affairs pointed out that, over 90% elderly in China wish to spend their old age at home. Therefore, the construction of community-based care for elderly is important. While China's existing community-based elderly care service models are diverse, service efficiency remains uneven. This study constructed a conceptual framework for community-based elderly care service based on the theory of welfare pluralism. Nine communities in Beijing, Nanjing, and Xi'an were selected based on geographical locations. Three supply modes are summarized, including multiactor participation, government and social organization cooperation, and government-led participation models. Case analysis method is used to analyze the characteristics of the supply actors, supply content, and supply methods of these three models. The supply mode of multiactor participation for community-based elderly care, which includes the participation of multiple subjects and is more diversified in terms of supply content and methods, is found to have higher supply efficiency.
