Prospective Student Requirements

- A foreign university with a degree authenticated by the Directorate General of Higher Education, Ministry of Education and Culture.

2. For the Psychometrics specialization, a foundation in basic statistics is required.

3. Willing to commit to full-time academic activities.

4. Submit a permission letter or recommendation from the relevant institution to pursue a master's degree.

5. Pass the Graduate Admission Test with a minimum TPA score of 475 (scale 1-700).

6. Achieve a minimum TOEFL score of 475 (scale 1-700), supported by an official certificate.

7. Submit a recommendation letter from the relevant institution to pursue a master's degree.

8. Submit a permission letter or recommendation from the relevant institution to pursue a master's degree.
